Note:- Parents are encouraged to use Net banking facility of either Indian Bank / any other banks for fee remittance rather than using Rupay/ Credit/ Debit Cards as it takes more Bank commission per transaction. Also advised to use offline facility of any Bank in your locality as it takes only Rs.5/- per transaction.
