Foreign Collaboration

In line with its global outlook, KEC made active academic and research collaborations with International Universities such as Universiti Teknologi MARA, Malaysia and Durban University of Technology, South Africa. We also have an active MoU with AHZ, UK university representative for fostering the higher education possibilities in UK universities.

The foreign academic and research partnership's goals are:

- a) Students should be exposed to a variety of cultures and global environments in order to improve their comprehension of liberal education practices generally rather than specifically.
- b) Provide the students an opportunity to study overseas so they can experience the thrill of learning and living in another country.
- c) Boost awareness and acceptance of collaborative learning and international education.
- d) To collaborate with other academics and multi-sectoral research projects in order to offer a forum for knowledge sharing.
- e) Make connections between students and colleges stronger.

As part of the MoU activities, joint research publications and patents were produced in reputed journals. Several research proposals were submitted for funding from governmental and non-governmental organizations. Faculty members actively participated in the collaborative supervision of undergraduate, postgraduate, and PhD students. KEC organizes various collaborative National and International Conferences in different streams to enhance the knowledge and capabilities of students & faculties. Joint Conferences organized with Universiti Teknologi MARA, Malaysia in February 2024 by the institution are:

- 1. International Conference on Technological Advancements in the field of Civil and Mechanical Engineering
- 2. International Conference on Intelligence Hardware Software Robotics
- 3. International conference on Advanced Computing ,Communication and Electrical system

The institution also facilitates an International Knowledge Exchange Program with Murdoch University, Australia fostering collaboration and knowledge sharing between its stakeholders and students from the international community.
